

Job Title: Finance Officer and Bookkeeper (Voluntary Role)

Role Overview:

We are looking for a dedicated and experienced Finance Officer and Bookkeeper to assist in managing the day-to-day financial operations of the charity. This volunteer role will support the CEO and help enable the day to day running of the charity. The position is ideal for someone with a background in finance or accounting who is passionate about our mission and eager to contribute to the charity's growth and sustainability.

Key Responsibilities:

- Financial Oversight:
 - Monitor financial transactions through online access to CAF Bank and ensure automated allocation of income and expenditure is accurate.
 - Oversee the processing of incoming invoices and cost claims, ensuring payments are subject to CEO authorisation.
 - Assist in the creation of ad hoc invoices based on CEO instructions.

• Bookkeeping and Payroll:

- Use Intuit QuickBooks Online for accounting, payroll, and reporting tasks.
- Manage monthly salary calculations, including HMRC submissions, and update employee pension schemes (NEST and Baptist Pension Scheme).
- Manually allocate income from CAF Donate, PayPal, and Stripe to the relevant sources.
- Maintain digital records of all income and expenditures for the charity.

• Compliance and Reporting:

- Prepare monthly management accounts, annual reports, and financial statements for submission to the Treasurer and Board of Trustees.
- Support the preparation of annual budgets in collaboration with the CEO and Treasurer.
- File Gift Aid claims and other government support schemes to ensure the charity benefits from eligible contributions.

• Collaboration with CEO:

Work closely with the CEO on financial strategy and key financial decisions.



• Provide ad hoc financial reports and attend Board of Trustees meetings when financial input is needed.

Additional Responsibilities:

- Act as an agent of the charity in maintaining financial and software systems.
- Ensure compliance with legal and regulatory financial requirements, particularly HMRC and charity governance.

Qualifications and Experience:

- Experience with financial management and bookkeeping, preferably using Intuit QuickBooks or similar software.
- Knowledge of UK charity finance regulations and experience managing payroll and Gift Aid claims.
- Excellent organisational and communication skills.
- Ability to work independently and make informed financial decisions in collaboration with the CEO.
- A passion for sports and a desire to contribute to the mission of Sports Chaplaincy UK and Ireland.
- GOR: A born again Christian and agree with EA statement of Faith.

- Compassionate and empathetic, with a genuine desire to see support and care provided for individuals within the sports community.
